This is to officially notify you that *U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP)/U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE)* seized the property described below at Houston, Texas on December 9, 2013:

The appraised domestic value of the property is \$175,061.00.

The property was seized and is subject to forfeiture under the provisions of Title 19 U.S.C. § 1595a(d) and Title 22 U.S.C. § 401 for violation of Title 22 U.S.C. § 2778, Control of arms exports and imports, Title 15 C.F.R. § 30.71(a)(1), false or fraudulent reporting on or misuse of the Automated Export System (AES), Title 15 C.F.R. § 30.3, Electronic Export Information filer requirements, parties to export transactions, and responsibilities of parties to export transactions and Title 15 C.F.R. § 30.6, Electronic Export Information (EEI) data elements.

The facts available to CBP indicate that you might have an interest in the seized property. The purpose of this letter is to advise you of the options available to you concerning this seizure. An important document is enclosed with this letter. Please do not ignore it. This document is the "Election of Proceedings" form. You should choose one of the options outlined below, indicate your choice on the "Election of Proceedings" form, and return it and any other necessary documents to CBP within the allotted time frame. Even if you are abandoning the property, you should complete the "Election of Proceedings" form and return it to CBP.
